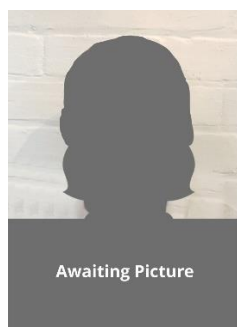

The Parish Council still has 7 places to fill by way of Co-option, if it could be for you and you would like to make a difference to where you live, the Parish Council would like to hear from you.

### Criteria to become a Councillor.

- Must be over 18 and on the electoral register or be a resident of the Parish or live within 3 miles of the Parish boundary as the crow flies.
  - Be able to attend monthly meetings.

**Congratulations** to Ellie Chowns who again has been elected as the Ward Councillor on the Herefordshire Council, the Parish Council looks forward to working with her, for the beneficial improvement of Cradley & Storridge.

The Parish Council would like to hear from any resident who would be interested in taking up the volunteer position of **Tree Warden** within the Parish. Cradley & Storridge have many trees which are protected by Tree Protection Orders (TRO) which helps keep the Parish looking green. Apart from this most of the Parish is in a Conservation area. You would be part of the Herefordshire Tree Warden's Association who will assist you in fulfilling this role.

The Parish Council has several working groups which have lay members, the Highways Working Group, the Recreation Grounds Working Group, and the new Environmental Working Group all have spaces for one or two lay members of the public.
