The Parish Council are looking to contract a self-employed parish Lengthsman/Handyman to undertake a range of tasks to help maintain:

1. The Council's public open spaces alongside other contractors like grass cutters etc.
2. The various Public Rights of Way (PROW) across the parish alongside landowners
3. Drains and gullies on rural U and C class lanes and roads
4. Hedges and vegetation on visibility splays affecting road and pathway safety
5. Parish signs and street furniture etc.

A full range of tasks and other requirements will be provided to interested parties.

The Council will let a three-year contract, subject to annual review, for an average of 24 hours a month, to be worked flexibly to reflect the seasons/time of year and weather conditions.

The Council look forward to hearing from interested parties who have the ability to being able to work alone with the minimum amount of supervision. The council will support the right candidate with some aspects of training so that they could fully undertake this role safely and to the required standards.
